

## How to light a fire in your stove...



For fire lighting you need:

- Big wood logs
- Small logs
- 2 firelighters
- Matches



Open the secondary damper.



Place a log of wood crosswise in the combustion chamber and put 2 firelighters close to the log and light the firelighters. Then place another log.

You need an ash layer of approx. 2-3 cm.



When the fire has been started, then place several small logs at an angle above it and open the primary damper. Air must be able to reach the firelighters, but the logs should be touching to “warm” each other. During the first 5-10 minutes you need to open the door a couple of times in order to remove steam from the glass. When the glass is too hot to touch the door has to stay closed.



Place the Aduro key in the two holes in the damper, so it is being kept open.



When there are big visible flames and the fire burns nicely, then remove the Aduro key.
